Ensure your supply chain is transparent, compliant, and ready to secure contracts.

1.	. Chemical Compliance — 🗹	
	Cross-check all purchased chemicals against the <b>ZDHC MRSL</b> (Manufacturing Restricted Substances List).	
	Maintain a <b>complete and up-to-date chemical inventory</b> (all substances used in production, auxiliary chemicals, maintenance, etc.).	
	Ensure every chemical has a <b>Safety Data Sheet</b> (SDS) in the local language + English	
	Verify each product's <b>CAS number</b> is correctly recorded.	
	Implement chemical substitutions for hazardous substances with safer alternatives	
	Track chemical usage across all production processes

	Maintain accurate records of raw material sources (invoices, delivery notes, batch numbers)	
	Verify supplier certifications (e.g., ZDHC Level-1-3, bluesign®, OEKO-TEX® Eco Passport, GOTS for auxiliaries).	
	Internal chemical audit reports (self-checks, twice a year).	
	Maintain internal SOPs for chemical and environmental management	
	Ensure traceable shipping and batch documentation

	Monitor wastewater treatment and discharge compliance	
	Track energy and water consumption per production unit	
	Implement waste reduction and recycling initiatives	
	Document initiatives for sustainable sourcing	
	Annual goals for reducing energy, water, and waste.	
	Track sustainability KPIs for reporting to brands

	Traceability system for raw materials and finished goods	
	Record production locations and batch tracking for every order	
	Maintain clear product lineage from raw material to finished goods	
	Verify all sub-suppliers' compliance and certifications	
	Ensure quick access to traceability information for audits

	Identify high-risk materials, processes, or suppliers	
	Conduct internal compliance audits regularly	
	Prepare documentation for brand or third-party audits	
	Maintain records of corrective actions taken for non-compliance	
	Review and update compliance processes at least annually
